

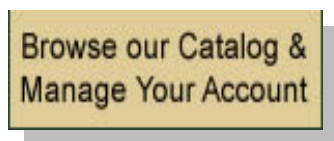
# How to access free books, audiobooks, eBooks, movies, and music using your Library Card

What you'll need:

- \* Your Library Card
- \* Pin # (usually the last 4 digits of your home phone number)
- \* A device with internet access

Ringwood Public Library is part of a consortium of libraries that allows borrowing between libraries. The website that acts as the online catalog is [PALSPlus](#).

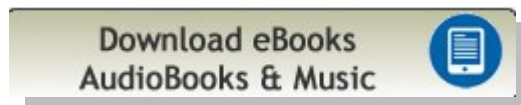
This site can be accessed from our website [www.ringwoodlibrary.org](http://www.ringwoodlibrary.org) in several places, including the E-Resources, Adult, Tweens & Teens, and Children's drop-down menus. It can also be accessed from these buttons:



Once on the PALSPlus site, you can search **physical items** (books, books on CD, music CDs, DVDs), then place holds on them. You can also review your account by clicking [My Account](#) at the top right of the screen.

Access **eBooks** via [www.overdrive.com](http://www.overdrive.com). Overdrive can be accessed from our website: select **EBooks & Audiobooks** from the *E-Resources & Downloads* drop-down menu or use this button on the right side of our home page:

From here, you can download books to your Kindle.



For streaming or downloading **audiobooks**, use Overdrive's [Libby app](#) on the device you'll be using to listen.

You can also use your library card with [Hoopla](#) and [RB Digital](#). Hoopla provides a selection of eBooks, audiobooks, music, and movies and is compatible with smart TVs. RB Digital is great for magazines. Both are available in the App Store and on Google Play.
